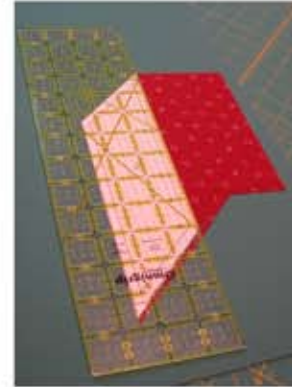


Women's Voices -Block 10 Lincoln's Log Cabin

Cut your 8 surrounding strips from the background fabric and set aside. Using an acrylic ruler measure your templates for size and cut all required pieces from background and fabrics 1-4. See tips below before cutting. I found that it helps to draw a cutting diagram for yourself on a piece of paper first to make sure you don't short your fabric. For the odd shaped pieces I cut out a paper template to place on the top of the fabric and then cut out using my acrylic ruler.

This block was fairly simple to piece until I got to the point where I had to inset the door unit. It was a bit challenging for me, but I figured it out! First stitch the roof unit to the house/window unit, then attach to the door unit. Stitch side seam along template M and stop 1/4" before the end. Then align template piece P along top of the door unit (template piece D) and pin the intersecting seam marking where you stopped the 1/4" seam and start stitching from there. This is a hard step to explain, but hopefully the picture below will help.



Add sashing and cornerstone pieces to complete blocks. I forgot to take a picture of my blocks with the cornerstones and sashing. But you know how it goes! :)
