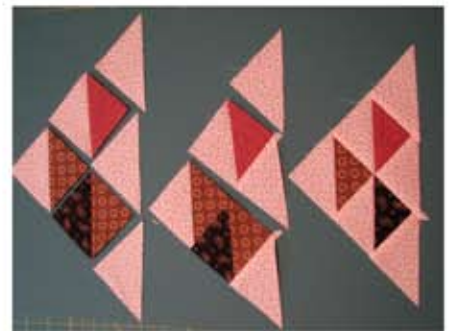


## Women's Voices -Block 11 Mrs. Cleveland's Choice

Cut your 8 surrounding strips from the background fabric and set aside. Using an acrylic ruler measure your templates for size and cut all required pieces from background and fabrics 1-4. See tips below before cutting. I found that it helps to draw a cutting diagram for yourself on a piece of paper first to make sure you don't short your fabric.

This was the most challenging block for me in this quilt. My best advice is to very carefully measure your templates or even copy and cut the templates out to make sure your measurements are exact. Some of the templates include 1/8" measurements.

To center triangles on shapes fold in half and mark the center with a pin or a crease on each piece and then match up centers.



Add sashing and cornerstone pieces to complete blocks.

I forgot to take a picture of my blocks with the cornerstones and sashing. But you know how it goes!
