

Women's Voices -Block 9 Old Tippecanoe & Tyler Too

Cut your 8 surrounding strips from the background fabric and set aside. Using an acrylic ruler measure your templates for size and cut all required pieces from background and fabrics 1-4. See tips below before cutting. I found that it helps to draw a cutting diagram for yourself on a piece of paper first to make sure you don't short your fabric.

This is a super easy block! The whole block is made using one template which can easily be made using half square triangles. Remember when making half square triangles you add 7/8" to your finished size square. I like to add a little extra and then trim down to get a perfect square.



My center square on the block to the left uses fabrics #3 and #4. The pattern says to use fabrics #2 and #4, but somehow I shorted myself on my fabric #2 so I substituted fabric #3 in its place. That's the great thing about this program. The four fabric pieces you receive each month are the same size so you have the freedom to use the colors however you like.

Add sashing and cornerstone pieces to complete blocks.
