



Women's Voices -Sashing and Cornerstones

You should now have 25 blocks completed. From your scraps cut out thirty-six $3\frac{1}{4}$ " cornerstones to go with your sashing. If you prefer all of your cornerstones to be the same color you will need $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of fabric.

For the sashing you will cut out sixty $15\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " strips. I cut the $15\frac{1}{2}$ " on the length of grain. See diagram below. If you cut $3\frac{1}{4}$ " strips on the width of fabric you may not have enough for all of your pieces.

Lay out your blocks however you like and add the sashing. You can also purchase additional fabric for borders if you would like to make the quilt bigger. Refer to your pattern for additional fabric requirements for borders.
