

BLOOMING NINE PATCH

Do you like to making distinctive looking quilts? This might be class for you. Blooming Nine Patch is a variation of a Trip Around the World and it uses just two basic blocks which will make a tried and true quilt. Class is suitable for Beginners and beyond!

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Fabric 1	3/8 yd	*1/2 yd
Fabric 2	5/8 yd	*3/4 yd
Fabric 3	3/4 yd	*7/8 yd
Fabric 4	1 yd	*1 1/8 yds
Fabric 5	1 3/8 yds	*1 1/2 yds
Fabric 6	1 5/8 yds	*1 3/4 yds
Fabric 7	1 7/8 yds	*2 yds
Fabric 8	1 1/8 yds	*1 1/2 yds

Wash and press all fabrics prior to class.

*This is the recommended yardage. Experience has shown that sometimes the book amounts have not been enough and you will not be able to cut the necessary number of strips.

**If you would like to add an additional border you will need an extra 2 5/8 yds of fabric 8.

Supplies:

Sewing Machine in good working order

Basic sewing supplies-pins, scissors, seam ripper, etc.

Neutral color thread

Rotary cutter, mat, rulers (I use a 24"/24.5" long ruler plus a shorter length ruler)

Book: Traditions With a Twist by Blanche Young required.
