



Beginning QUILTING

at Quilting by the Bay

Seven 2-hour classes

This class will introduce you to quilting by machine and rotary cutting. You'll learn tips and tricks to make your quilting journey a successful one. One of our knowledgeable staff members will lead you through each and every step of our comprehensive 7-session course. You will learn how to make good color choices, rotary cutting skills, proper piecing techniques, machine quilting your quilt and binding ... everything you'll need to become a successful quilter! You must be comfortable operating your sewing machine to take this class. You will make a baby or lap size quilt. We request you purchase fabrics for this project from Quilting by the Bay.

Supply List:

- A loose-leaf notebook with page protectors
- Notebook paper and pencil
- Fabrics listed below to make your quilt
- Sewing machine, cord, foot control, a walking foot, a 1/4" foot, and a free motion foot for quilting
- Rotary mat - 18" x 24" preferred
- Rotary cutter – 45mm preferred with a new blade
- Acrylic rulers – Creative Grids 6 1/2" x 24 1/2" and 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" preferred
- A spool of neutral colored 100% cotton thread – 50 weight Aurifil or Mettler preferred
- Basic sewing supplies including pins, seam ripper, and scissors
- New size 80/12 Microtex Sharp sewing machine needles

	Baby	Lap
Finished size	39" x 48"	61" square
Background fabric	1 1/3 yds.	1 3/4 yds.
Color A – Nine Patch fabric	1 1/4 yds.	1 3/4 yds.
Color B – Inner border and Monkey Wrench	1 1/2 yds.	1 1/4 yds.
Outer border (nondirectional prints only)	1 1/2 yds.	2 yds.

Note: If you choose a directional print for the outer border, you will have to buy 2 3/4 yards for the lap size and you will have to piece the top and bottom border. We prefer you select a non-directional print

Before Class:

- Purchase your fabric and press it.
- Check to make sure you have all the rotary-cutting equipment listed on the supply sheet.
- Wind several bobbins.
