With the Fabric Selection and Cutting Chart for the Flying Geese: Part A1 as a guide, you place the fabrics on top of each other. When you are finished placing the fabrics on top on each other, turn the pile upside down. Now your stack from top down is in the order: 24, 14, *, 13, 1, 15, 15, 2, 16, 16, 3, 17, 17, 4, 18, 18, 5, 19, 19, 6, 20 and finally fabric 20, just like the fabric selection chart.

Fabric and Cutting Chart for part J: The small Black Star

Fabric 26	Cut 5 strips, 2¾" x 44"	Foundation point 1, odd points (1, 3, 5, 7). Cut 36 pieces: 2¾"x 5¼". Cut 8 pieces from the first four strips and 4 pieces from the fifth strip.
Fabric 26	Cut 3 strips, 4¾" x 44"	Foundation point 1, even points (2, 4, 6, 8). Cut 36 pieces: 4¾"x 3¼". Cut 13 pieces from the first two strips and 10 pieces from the third strip.
Fabrics 3, 5, 7, 10, 12, 16, 19 & 23		Foundation point 2, odd and even points. Cut from the 8 selected fabrics 1 strip of 2¼" x 44". Cut from each strip 9 pieces of: 3¼" x 2¼".

For one star we have to make eight star points: J-1, J-2, J-3, J-4, J-5, J-6, J-7 & J-8. The base of the star is foundation point 1. We always will use fabric 26 for this foundation point. For foundation point 2 we use, for each of the eight different star points one of the eight colors: 3, 5, 7, 10, 12, 16, 19 & 23.

Fabric and Cutting Chart for Part K & L: The Ellipse and the Arch

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We use fabric 27 for foundation point #1. Foundation point 1 is the spine in the center of the first ellipse. The fabric for the outside of the ellipse is always 1x fabric 25 for foundation point 2 and 1x fabric 26 for foundation point 3.

Fabric and Cutting Chart for part M: The 4 large white Stars

Fabric 25	Cut 2 strips: 7¾" x 44"	Foundation point 1, odd points (1, 3, 5, 7). Cut 16 pieces: 7¾" x 4¼". Cut 10 pieces from the first strip and 6 pieces from the second strip.					
Fabric 25	Cut 2 strips: 8½" x 44"	Foundation point 1, even points (2, 4, 6, 8). Cut 16 pieces: 8½" x 3¼". Cut 12 pieces from the first strip and 4 pieces from the second strip.					
To make optimal use of the 8 fabrics for the eight star points I have made a special cutting schedule to cut the fabrics for the star points in a fast, easy and precise way.

Cut 1 strip of 2" x 44" in the following colors: 2, 7, 12 & 19 and sub cut each strip in 8 pieces for the odd points

The four white stars in Fanciful Flight are designed with nine different fabrics, the fabrics: 2, 5, 7, 10, 12, 16, 19 & 23 and of course fabric 25 for the base of the star.

Parts N and O: The Outer Border

Cut the paper templates for Parts N and O, the **Outer Border** pieces. Fold fabric 25 in half and place the paper templates for the outer border parts on top of it. Place the template for Part N, the corner piece, on fabric 25 and cut the template two times to yield 4 pieces of fabric.

Still using the folded fabric 25, place the paper templates for Part O on to the fabric. Make four cuts to yield 8 pieces of fabric. Use a marking pencil to transfer the registration marks onto the fabric and remove the templates gently from the fabric.
